In assembly on Monday we presented the athletics trophies for 2010. Congratulations to all students who performed so well.

Our Year 9 students participated in their two day Aquatics Programme at the Timaru Pool and Caroline Bay, this week. The comprehensive programme included essential water safety, life saving and survival, beach safety and first aide. The fantastic weather and water conditions meant that students participated fully. A real highlight was the good surf conditions which were ideal for learning kayak skills at the beach.

Two Lincoln University presenters took our Year 12 students through an interesting programme on leadership skills that involved the students participating in various team activities. As well, students identified their own leadership style.

On Tuesday afternoon and Wednesday morning all Year 12 students participated in a leadership course run by Lincoln University.

Our Instructors, Anna and Laura taught us about our personality types and how to get on with people with different personalities. We also talked about how to deal with younger students. We also played initiative and teamwork games which included a blindfolded obstacle course and a game where we had to carry 3 people on our backs to get from one side of a "swamp" to another. These games helped build teamwork and initiative between each other and ourselves. Everyone really enjoyed the course and we would recommend it to all of the future Year 12 students.
